EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

Perspective Development Skills is seeking funds to continue the construction of the classrooms to allow the Primary Students (School of Dream) to be enrolled into the school, commencing in year 2023/2024. Meanwhile, these funds would be used for the construction of an orphanage.

The PDS Charity School Board of Management and Administration considers that education is fundamental to life and national development and that learning has no boundaries and no end. Whether we live in tribal or modern communities, the need for learning is there and so educating our children in the modern context is essential not only to prepare them for intellectual excellence but also to develop their correct mindsets on issues within and outside their community.

This school is meant to be a Center for Skills Development and Jobs Creation, which is the focus of PDS organization. It is offering free education for children and entrepreneurship trainings for the youth after school hours. Then, all ophans and vulnerable children will have the opportunity to start their life in PDS, where we can provide all basic requirement and improve their life standard.

We started to build the Nursery School in Kibele Village in 2019 thanks to the initiative of a volunteer from Belgium, who launched a fundraising campaign in her country. In 2020 we completed two classrooms. The Nursery School opened in September 30th, 2020, welcoming 72 children, especially orphans and vulnerable children. In this year 2022, thanks to DIY Group from France and Have a Dream Organization from Egypt through their volunteering program to support Africa, 2 more classrooms opened. We can now host 200 students at the same time.

However, as a school grows, the number of students increases. Now we have received a lot of applications of children and the youth to join different programs of PDS School including primary education, but the main challenge is space. The overall goal of the project is to build a Dream School in Jendele Village (close to Kibele), that can provide basic quality education for children and entrepreneurship skills for adults. Transport between the Nursery School in Kibele and the Primary School in Jendele will be provided by school buses. The School in Jendele will be able to accommodate 600 students at the same time. The project also intends to build an orphanage to provide care, support and protection for a total of 112 orphans and vulnerable children.

PDS Charitable Organization officially requests a fund of TZS 395,600,000/= (\$172,000): TZS 230,000,000/= (\$100,00) to implement the PDS School Project and TZS 165,600,000/= (\$72,000) for the orphanage building.


PROJECT'S LOCATION & SOCIO-ECONOMIC CONDITIONS

Zanzibar is a semi-autonomous archipelago of Tanzania and has a total population of roughly one million and half. While the islands were once the world's biggest producer of cloves, international competition and other global factors have caused clove sales to decrease by 80 percent since the 1970s. Poverty levels on the island are high, and child labor is common, especially during harvest times and the main tourist season. Child prostitution, often catering to sex tourists, also exists in the country.

The government has succeeded in reducing malaria prevalence to almost one percent, but other health issues continue to affect the population. HIV/AIDS and Non Communicable Disease are still endangering many lives and can lead to family breakdown.



The village of Jendele has a population of 3,354. It is located in Central District, South Region, Zanzibar (Tanzania). The household size average at Jendele is 5 persons.



BACKGROUND

PDS Charitable Organization has witnessed majority of the young children walking long distances to access the only one government school of Jendele Village. Some children reached school as late as 8:30 am (the schools start at 7am in Zanzibar), and a number of them crossed high traffic roads in the morning to reach the school, putting their lives at risk.

Majority of children in Jendele village cannot read and write properly. Most of the children in Jendele village live under poor life conditions because their parents don't have any job. PDS has also witnessed some children who give up just because they lost either one of their parents or both.

We, PDS, have seen the needs to bring quality school services near these children and build an orphanage can provide good life for them. This orphanage would be destined especially to children from Jendele Village, but we can also accept children from rural Zanzibar who are in need.

Therefore, PDS is now looking for support to build a Primary School and Innovation Center (SCHOOL OF DREAMS) so that next year our children from Nursery School in Kibele Village can continue their studies while they are still in our hands. We will be just moving from Kibele village to JENDELE village because the Government of Zanzibar has recently donated 5 hectares of land to PDS organization. Students from PDS Nursery School in Kibele Village will be provided transport service by PDS in order to attend their class in PDS Primary School in Jendele Village.

The good news is that one among PDS partners from Switzerland, Hope Organization, will donate a bus to PDS that can be used to transfer children from one place to another.

PROBLEMS ENCOUNTERED

The number of pupils' enrolment in Nursery school increases each year. PDS just welcomes a few of them. The rest - which corresponds to the majority of the pupils - cannot go to school because of the lack of space in PDS Charity School and other neighbor schools.

The situation in rural area communities of Zanzibar is worse than expected. Children walk an average distance of 3 kilometers to access the closest school.

As a result of this phenomenon, children between 4 and 7 years old do not go to school. Reports from the schools near these rural communities indicate that children are always late for school and are not punctual due to the long distance.

Moreover, poverty level in Zanzibar Island is high and child labor is common, especially during harvesting seasons and the main touristic season. This happen mainly for the children from poor families.

This situation is affecting the development of Zanzibar and Tanzania in general. For this reasons, our NGO has designed this project consisting in building the «Dream school» and an orphanage for rural communities. The objective is to provide an educational facility to help improve the social well-being of children from rural communities as well as providing quality of life for the children in need.




PROSPECTIVE

There is a long term plan for the development of PDS Charity School. The plan is logically set up to show the importance of providing a "School of Dreams" for the children of the rural Zanzibar.

The Perspective Development Skills (PDS) and the administration took the initiative of improving the current Nursery School in Kibele Village and require funding to implement this project. The students from PDS Nursery School will continue their studies in this « School of Dreams » that will be located in Jendele village, where PDS will have its permanent accommodation.

Apart from this « School of Dreams », PDS is planning to build other infrastructures such as Hospital, Community Center, Vocational Training, Football Pitch, Staff houses and Volunteers Hostel.

PROJECT'S OBJECTIVE

- To provide better, affordable and reachable education services to the children in both Kibele and Jendele villages;
- To support children in need of care and protection and to help destitute poor, neglected needy and orphan children;
- To promote and provide formal and informal education to the children, functional literacy in the community they live and vocational training to the youth;
- To address the issues of poverty that hinders child survival, their growth and development;
- To create employment opportunities for teachers and support staff in both Kibele and Jendele;
- To reduce the rate of crimes.

PROJECT'S BENEFITS

The benefits of the project can be categorized into educational and social benefits.

The primary beneficiaries of the project are the school children, especially in nursery and primary school. They will now be able to further their education to the lower primary school level (standard 1 up to 7) and soon an opportunity to continue into the secondary school level (form 1 to 4). But also this building will be opportunity for young people to learn about entrepreneurship skills.

On the social benefits, education is fundamental to life and national development. With better education and skills, we can really change the peoples' life in our community.

POTENTIAL LONG-TERM IMPACT

This project will have a big impact on orphans and street children. Their basic needs will be met and they will get a new life through gaining knowledge, vocational skills & life skills. They will get love and affection as their parents provide. Their confidence level will increase and become a good asset to the community. This project will develop the children physically and psychologically. They will become good as productive citizens, inspired by philanthropy and showing humanity towards the community.

PROJECT'S RESULTS

- Improved quality education;
- Create 25 employment opportunities;
- Build permanent classrooms and offices;
- Increased number of school children;
- Recruit more teaching and non-teaching staff members.

BENEFICIARIES

The beneficiaries will be:

- 1. The children from Zanzibar rural especially from Kibele and Jendele villages.
- 2. The children in PDS Nursery School who shall join Primary school.
- 3. The teachers and support staff working in this school.
- 4. Young people who will learn entrepreneurship skills.
- 5. Orphans and vulnerable children.

MONITORING & EVALUATION

The project will be monitored at regular intervals through a "Project Advisory Committee (PAC)" constituted by the Director General of the organization as convener/member secretary. Members from the funding organization, local district administration etc., will be nominated as members of the Project Advisory Committee.

This committee would meet annually and advice on various aspects concerning the implementation of the project and review of the programs/activities undertaken. The Project Advisory Committee will also review the accounts and audited statements. This meeting can be in person or online depending on the availability of members.

PDS has an Education and Trainings Department which supervises PDS Charity School. The Department is run by the Director of Education and Trainings, who reports directly to the Director General of PDS Zanzibar.

The PDS board of directors is comprised of four PDS members to be responsible for implementing most of the decisions made in the management meetings. The head teacher reports directly to the school principle, who also reports to the Director of Education and Trainings. Then, as the school is comprised of different departments, the heads of departments report to the head teacher. All support staff of the school reports to the respective heads of departments.

Consequently, the Education and Trainings Department will monitor and evaluate monthly and they will be required to submit monthly reports to the Director General of PDS Zanzibar.

PDS Charity School has one major partner: DIY (Dauphine International Youth). Their help mainly consists in building infrastructures and giving food support for our children and community. Support from PDS Organization consists in running the school daily activities.

We are currently developing a partnership with Hope organization from Switziland. We believe they can help us in running this project.

Still, the opportunity of new partnerships is open to all who may want to support this project either to help running the school by sponsoring the children in need or to help in construction cost (or both).






