CONTEXT

One of the main goal of our association was to improve access to education for children around the world. Our first international project took place in February 2022 in Zanzibar, Tanzania, at a nursery school for 70 pupils orphaned or from very poor families. Most of the pupils, aged 3 to 8, lived in extreme poverty, despite their shining smiles.

The facilities are often under-staffed and unable to meet the needs of all the children. Our initial aim was to provide them with school supplies, including notebooks, pens, slates and other materials, working in collaboration with a local association called PDS (Perspective Development Skills registered under Societies Act No. 6 of 1995, registration number L.2712). Thanks to this first action, we were able to discern the needs of the school's pupils and teachers. So our team decided to get together to design sustainable projects to contribute to their development.

1. BUILDING AN ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

The first objective is directly linked to the goals of the PDS association. The main goals of this charitable organization are job creation and poverty reduction. To achieve these objectives, PDS empowers local people living in rural areas of Zanzibar by providing them with skills and access to education. The school currently has only a nursery school and in order to provide a sustainable education for these children, the association plans to build an elementary school to ensure continuity in the education program for its students. This is why the first objective will be to build and equip a primary classroom for 30 to 40 children.

2. SCHOOL BUS

The second problem affecting these children's access to education is the lack of transport. In fact, many of them have to carpool despite their young age, or walk several miles to get to school on roads that are sometimes difficult to access and close to car traffic, making the roads dangerous. During bad weather (rain or other), most roads are no longer accessible and children are no longer able to get to school. So, the second need identified and essential to the development of the local association is the purchase of a school bus that can pick up children to go to school and drop them off at home once school is over. The bus will also facilitate school trips and other necessary travel.

This project is the result of more than a year of effort and planning. Driven by a deep conviction to provide access to education and contribute to a better world for disadvantaged children in the villages of Zanzibar, we decided to make this dream a reality.

In less than 3 weeks, we were able to ensure the construction of the school, allocate your donations in the best possible way and coordinate this beautiful project we've been telling you about for several months already.

September 28, 2023 marked the inauguration of a building created from scratch, housing two classrooms and an office for the teachers. All this became a reality thanks to the hard work and commitment of our team in collaboration with **PDS**, the workers/technicians, **EighteenHills**, **Football Field** and the support of **SourireÀTous** and all our generous donors.

The painters put the finishing touches to the logos just in time to welcome the excitement of the children, who celebrated this incredible event with a festive snack, a kit of school supplies, and even by leaving their fingerprints on the wall before attending their first class.

We were honored and privileged to welcome the chief of the village as well as an imam to celebrate this magical moment in the respect of Zanzibar traditions, with a speech from each, celebrating this initiative.

A successful mission, filled with effort, collaboration and love, brightened by the smiles of all these children.

The second phase of our project was aimed at solving a fundamental problem for the village's children: the acquisition of a school bus to enable them to overcome the long journeys they have to make each morning and evening to get to school.

After extensive research prior to our arrival and during our stay in town, we finally managed to get our hands on a school bus capable of carrying 30 pupils. This will ensure that children who live a long way from the school will be able to attend classes run by the local association free of charge, even in rainy weather.

Moreover, the bus will be used for school trips, enabling this future generation to enjoy exploring the beautiful roads of Zanzibar. $rac{1}{\sim}$

This year, the Paris-based streetfootball community EighteenHills decided to join us in our project.

We thought it would be interesting to incorporate the theme of sport into our project, which is very important in children's development, in addition to our main focus on education.

And they didn't come empty-handed!

As well as building a school and buying a school bus, this year we organized a soccer tournament between teams from the surrounding villages, while providing sports equipment and materials. Independently of hope, the collective has organized its own fundraising campaign in order to organize the tournament and carry out their various actions.

Together, we believe that sport goes beyond borders, that it can break down barriers and open doors to a better future.

We are proud to present our humanitarian project, which unites the power of sport and education to create a positive impact in the lives of those who need it most.











GAME DAY

The first streetfootball tournament organized by **EighteenHills** in Africa took place in the village of Jenbele in Zanzibar on September 23 and 24, 2023.

The tournament was the fruit of a long-term work by the **EighteenHills** team in collaboration with **Football Field**, **Hope**, **PDS** and the support of **Sourire À Tous** and all donors.

The objectives: Provide sports equipment for the players of the tournament, to promote soccer in the villages of Zanzibar, to bring our love and passion to those in need.

Street soccer is a brand new concept for them, 4vs4 in three categories (Men / Women / Children). Over 500 people gathered to take part in this incredible event.

The winners had the opportunity to play against the **EighteenHills** team, and above all to receive **an extraordinary prize - a goat**. A precious source of food and income in Tanzania.

The best male and female players in each category were also rewarded and thanked by the district president, the referees and the speakers, before coming together to dance with the children.

A tournament full of *life*, *respect* and *love*.













The best player in each team was rewarded with a pair of football boots. But a special reward was given **for each winning team**.

In Tanzania, as in many other African countries, goats are **a valuable source of food and income.**

Farmers benefit from their milk and meat, whether for their own consumption or for sale. They are **an asset for poor families** who cannot afford to buy cows.

















DISTRIBUTION

The Eighteen Hills community was also able to distribute of 100 football shirts at different spots in Zanzibar.

The initial goal was to meet soccer players in the villages.

Many Zanzibar players don't have the chance to play in good conditions (bare feet, punctured balls, torn t-shirts, etc.).

That is why, **after meeting and playing soccer with the locals**, Eighteen Hills distributed football shirts and balls to around a hundred people (men, women and children) in various locations (beaches, villages, neighborhoods).

This initiative helped strengthen ties with the local population and to identify needs for future actions.
